

Pattern 1. Thank you for \sim

Thank you for ~ (~をありがとうございます) の学習



1. Usage 使い方 (Explain the usage of "Thank you for ~")

Example 1: 例文1

Thank you for the nice present.

すてきな贈り物をありがとう。

The phrase "Thank you for \sim " is used to express appreciation to someone for offering or giving something to you. The word "for \sim " explains the reason for the gratitude.

この " \sim thank you for \sim " は、何かを申し出てくれたりしてくれたときに用いる表現で、「 \sim をありがとうございます」、「 \sim に感謝します」という意味です。 多くは Thank you for \sim という形で使用されますが、主語をはっきりさせたい場合には、」 や We をつけます。

たとえば、Thank you for your kindness. は、主語を明確にしたい場合には、We thank you for your kindness. と表現します。

Example 3: 例文 3

Q: What do people thank you for not doing in a park or a public space? (not smoking)

公園や公共の場所では、何をしないことを感謝されますか?

A: They thank you for not smoking. 禁煙が感謝されます。

Q1: What do people thank you for not doing about waste paper and containers? (not littering)

Q2: What do people thank you for not doing about excessive perfume? (not wearing)

Q3: What do people thank you for not doing about the way you talk with them? (beating around the bush)
